Among other things, Dr. Simon's discovery of opiate receptors in the brain blazed the trail for modern research toward an understanding of the biological basis of drug addiction & pain. The research impacts addiction and pain and has provided and will continue to provide new information useful in the study of other diseases & disorders of the brain, For work like this to continue, it is critical that funding continue to be available.

The Foundation will encourage young scientists to enter this important field of research as well as focus public attention on the important, yet frequently overlooked, area – basic research of the human brain.

Ideas and goals For funds Raised

- 1. Set up a Speakers' Bureau, at first, regional and eventually national. Such a Speakers' Bureau would make available speakers to community groups and businesses to talk about the current state of the art of brain research and how basic research is affecting and will affect the cure and prevention of brain diseases, such as drug and alcohol addiction and pain, as well as other diseases. Speakers, who are experts on the state of the art of the treatment of pain and addiction, will also be asked to join the speaker list. Drs. Carr, Reith and E. Simon will look into setting this up.
- 2. IES Brain Research Foundation summer internships for brilliant college seniors and beginning graduate students will be set up in laboratories with scientists, who volunteer to take on such students. This will give young science-oriented students a chance to see whether brain research is a career they would be excited to pursue and hopefully help attract excellent new talent to the field. Dr. Howells agreed to take a leadership role in this effort.
- **3.** Setting up one or more lectures at prestigious scientific conferences and/or medical institutions is another suggested activity for the Foundation.
- **4**. As more money becomes available, a symposium on a topic related to the Foundation's interests may be sponsored.
- **5.** Future goals for when larger amounts are raised are giving modest grants or purchasing a needed piece of equipment for a lab doing outstanding brain research


